**QUESTION:**

Will the Attorney-General advise how many children in Queensland aged between 10 and 11 years old have been found guilty of committing an offence in 2017-18 (reported separately by each offence)?

**ANSWER:**

The question of how many children have been found guilty of committing an offence in 2017-18 falls within the responsibilities of the Honourable Di Farmer MP, Minister for Child Safety, Youth and Women and Minister for the Prevention of Domestic and Family Violence.
