

## Question on Notice

Asked on 6 September 2018

**MR R STEVENS** asked the Minister for Health and Minister for Ambulance Services (HON DR S MILES) –

### QUESTION

Will the Minister advise, for the Medical Aids Subsidy Scheme (reported separately by year), (a) the budget for 2018-19 to 2020-21 and (b) the actual expenditure for 2016-17 and 2017-18?

### ANSWER

As Queensland government funding is progressively transferred to the National Disability Insurance Scheme, the provision of medical aids is increasingly becoming an NDIS responsibility.

The budget for the Medical Aids Subsidy Scheme (MASS) current financial year and forward financial years to 2020-21 is as follows:

- 2018-19 \$30.3 million;
- 2019-20 \$27 million; and
- 2020-21 \$27 million.

MASS actual expenditure for 2016-17 and 2017-18 follows:

- 2016-17 \$40.9 million; and
- 2017-18 \$38.7 million.
