**MRS D FRECKLINGTON** ASKED THE ATTORNEY-GENERAL AND MINISTER FOR JUSTICE (HON Y D'ATH) –

## QUESTION:

With reference to Division 5 of Part 2 of the Dangerous Prisoners (Sexual Offenders) Act 2003 (Qld) which applies if a police officer or corrective services officer reasonably suspects a released prisoner is likely to contravene, is contravening, or has contravened, a requirement of the released prisoner's supervision order or interim supervision order—

Will the Attorney-General advise how many warrants for the arrest of a released prisoner have been issued in 2017-18 (reported separately by region)?
