MR N DAMETTO ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND MINISTER FOR CORRECTIVE SERVICES (HON M RYAN) —

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise whether the State Government will provide a fair go to modified four wheel drive owners by removing the unnecessary type 2 illegal modifications category from the Newman Government's anti-hooning laws?

ANSWER:

I am advised by the Queensland Police Service (QPS) there are a range of offences against the *Transport Operations (Road Use Management) Act 1995* which are defined as type 2 vehicle related offences under the *Police Powers and Responsibilities Act 2000* for which the QPS can take enforcement action.

I am advised that the Honourable Mark Bailey MP, Minister for Transport and Main Roads is best placed to answer the question about the four wheel drive modifications relating to vehicle lift rules under the Queensland Code of Practice and consistency with the National Code of Practice, as this falls within his portfolio.
