MR S O'CONNOR ASKED MINISTER FOR HOUSING AND PUBLIC WORKS; MINISTER FOR DIGITAL TECHNOLOGY; MINISTER FOR SPORT (HON M DE BRENNI)

Will the Minister advise the number of public housing properties within the electorate of Bonney for the last five years (reported separately by suburb and year)?

ANSWER

The Palaszczuk Government's *Housing Construction Jobs Program* is a key initiative of the *Queensland Housing Strategy 2017-2027* which will provide a \$1.6 billion investment to deliver more social and affordable housing over the next 10 years in priority regions across the state. The program focuses on providing more housing in key population and economic growth areas to help address the State's long-term housing needs by supporting and accelerating new construction and precinct development.

Over the first five years of the Strategy, the Palaszczuk Government is investing \$110 million to deliver 392 new social housing homes in the Gold Coast Region.

In just under 18 months the Palaszczuk Government has commenced 60 new safe, secure and sustainable homes on the Gold Coast, which is in stark contrast to the LNP Government's record of 52 homes over three years.
