**MS J PEASE** asked the Minister for Health and Minister for Ambulance Services (HON DR S MILES) –

## QUESTION

Will the Minister advise (a) what health services are currently operating and (b) how many patients have been seen since commissioning at the Wynnum Manly Community Centre, Gundu Pa, including the Primary Care Clinic?

## ANSWER

(a) The Wynnum-Manly Community Health Centre, Gundu Pa is the new state-ofthe-art public health facility for the Wynnum-Manly community. It offers a wide range of health services for the local area, many of them new or expanded.

Gundu Pa has provided the local community with access to a 24-hour Primary Care Centre. It also provides Oral Health and Breast Screen services, as well as the following specialist services: Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy, Speech Therapy, Social Work, Dietitian, Hydrotherapy, Endocrinology, General Medicine, General Surgery, Respiratory, Midwifery, Diabetes, Psychiatry, Paediatric Medicine, Gynaecology, Cardiology, and Obstetrics.

(b) The Wynnum-Manly Community Health Centre has provided a total of 29,139 occasions of service since opening in October 2017 through to 31 August 2018. This comprises 11,949 occasions of service for 24-hour primary care, 4,327 for Specialist Clinics, 9,113 for Oral Health services, and 3,750 for Breast Screen services.
