Question on Notice No. 1225 Asked on 18 September 2018

MR J KRAUSE ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND MINISTER FOR CORRECTIVE SERVICES (HON M RYAN)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise the number of persons that have been charged with manslaughter in relation to a child from 2015-16 to 2017-18 (reported separately by year)?

ANSWER:

I have been advised by the Queensland Police Service that there were four persons charged with manslaughter in relation to a child in 2015-16, there were six persons charged in 2016-17, and there was one person charged in 2017-18.

I am pleased to inform the Member that the Palaszczuk Government has requested the Queensland Sentencing Advisory Council (QSAC), a body the former LNP government abolished, to examine the important issue of penalties imposed on sentence for criminal offences arising from the death of a child.

Notes:

- 1. This data is preliminary and may be subject to change.
- 2. Charges for manslaughter relate to sections 303 and 310 of the Criminal Code and is based on the time the person was charged.
- 3. Persons charged refer to a unique offender count. A person with multiple charges will be counted once in any breakdown.
- ${\bf 4.\ Only\ victims\ under\ 18\ at\ the\ time\ of\ the\ offence\ being\ reported\ to\ police\ have\ been\ included.}$
