QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise how the residents in the electorate of Bancroft will benefit from the rollout of QLiTE devices for the Queensland Police Service, as funded by the Palaszczuk Government in the 2018-19 State Budget?

ANSWER:

The Palaszczuk Government remains committed to keeping Queenslanders safe by providing our police with the latest mobile technology, including QLiTE devices and body worn video cameras.

In 2018-19, 13 additional devices have been issued to police officers stationed in the Bancroft electorate.

QLiTE devices continue to put the Queensland Police Service ahead of other public safety agencies when it came to innovative and effective mobility.

These capabilities help our frontline staff spend less time behind their station's computers and more time in our communities keeping Queenslanders safe.

QLiTE provides frontline officers with access to mobile applications to assist in daily duties that improve the capabilities and safety of officers.

These applications provide real-time, in-the-field access to timely and accurate information.

QLiTE enables officers to perform duties such as booking on and off at incidents, issue electronic infringement notices, submit reports in relation to missing people, deaths and crashes, view offender history and refer people to external support services – all while they are out on the road.
