MR S BENNETT ASKED MINISTER FOR EDUCATION AND MINISTER FOR INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS (HON G GRACE)

QUESTION:

Will the Minister list (by school name only) those Queensland state schools that are implementing, either in part or completely, the Daniel Morcombe Child Safety Curriculum?

ANSWER:

The decision to implement the Daniel Morcombe Child Safety Curriculum is made by principals, in consultation with their local school communities.

In a statewide collection of school information conducted in 2018, school principals of 435 state primary and secondary schools indicated they were accessing the Daniel Morcombe Child Safety Curriculum materials; however, this does not necessarily indicate the schools are implementing the curriculum.
