MR A HARPER ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND MINISTER FOR CORRECTIVE SERVICES (HON M RYAN)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise on the progress of a new police facility in the Upper Ross area of the Thuringowa Electorate since I tabled my petition seeking support for a new facility for our local police?

ANSWER:

The Palaszczuk Government continues to support our police by investing in the resources and infrastructure they need to keep Queenslanders safe.

I am informed the purchase of a site to support policing services in Upper Ross settled on 10 October 2018.

Planning is now underway for the fit-out of the building to meet operational needs, with the facility expected to become operational in early 2019.
