MR M MCARDLE asked the Minister for Health and Minister for Ambulance Services (HON DR S MILES) –

QUESTION

Will the Minister advise (a) the budget for BreastScreen Queensland from 2014-15 to 2017-18 (reported separately by year), (b) the number of screenings provided for those same years (reported separately by year) and (c) the allocated budget for 2018-19?

ANSWER

For the Queensland Health BreastScreen Queensland Program:

(a) the allocated budget was:

2014-15 - \$54.6 million
2015-16 - \$58.6 million
2016-17 - \$58.3 million
2017-18 - \$58.8 million

(b) the number of breast screens provided was:

2014-15 - 242,948
2015-16 - 250,404
2016-17 - 246,472
2017-18 - 251,154 (the highest year on record)

(c) the allocated budget for 2018-19 is \$61.4 million.
