MR S BENNETT asked the Minister for Child Safety, Youth and Women and Minister for the Prevention of Domestic and Family Violence (HON D FARMER)—

QUESTION

With reference to Child Safety Officer (CSO) case loads—

Will the Minister advise (a) how long it currently takes, on average, to reallocate cases of CSO's departing or taking extended leave and (b) in the last year, the longest amount of time taken for reallocating cases after a CSO departure?

ANSWER

The information requested is operational and is not centrally available.

Child Safety Officers continue to respond to and support the needs of vulnerable children, young people and families when staff depart or take extended leave.
