MRS S WILSON ASKED MINISTER FOR EDUCATION AND MINISTER FOR INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS (HON G GRACE)

QUESTION:

Will the Minister outline why the serious congestion issue at Banksia Beach State School, which occurs at drop-off and pick-up times, has taken so long to address and what actions are planned to remedy this?

ANSWER:

The Department of Education has been working with Banksia Beach State School to design additional car parking and a set down area, which will assist in reducing congestion at peak school travel times of drop-off and collection.

Once the detailed design has been finalised, the department will invite tenders for the construction of the new car park and set down area.
