# QUESTION

With reference to the 2017-18 consultancy expenditure for the Department of Communities, Disability Services and Seniors (DCDSS) —

Will the Minister provide a detailed breakdown as to what projects/advice were completed in the 'professional/technical' category, and how much each project/advice cost?

## ANSWER

Total consultancy expenditure for DCDSS in 2017-18 was \$248,681, as per the public reporting in the Queensland Government open data website. However I note that the 2017-18 figure includes consultancies relating to Child and Family Services, incurred prior to machinery of government changes in December 2017, by the then Department of Communities, Child Safety and Disability Services.
