QUESTION:

With reference to the Queensland Government's approach to the tendering for projects—  
Will the Premier advise why the Department of Education and Department of Health continued to permit the JM Kelly Group to tender for, and win, government contracts, while the Department of Housing and Public Works have taken the position, in light of the concerns raised by the Queensland Building and Construction Commission, that the JM Kelly Group is not permitted to tender for its projects, until matters before the Queensland Civil and Administration Tribunal are determined?
