# **MR M BOOTHMAN** ASKED MINISTER FOR AGRICULTURAL INDUSTRY DEVELOPMENT AND FISHERIES (HON M FURNER)—

### **QUESTION**:

With reference to Queensland's Shark Control Program-

Will the Minister advise the total program budget, FTE staff allocation and the total number of nets and drumlines established across the state from 2014-15 to 2017-18 (reported separately for each measure by year)?

#### **ANSWER:**

I thank the Member for the question.

# **Program Funding:**

The total program spend (actual) and FTE between 2014/15 and 2017/18 are below:

Year	Program spend (actual)	FTE
2017/18	\$3.6 million	3
2016/17	\$3.3 million	3
2015/16	\$3.4 million	3
2014/15	\$3.1 million	3

The program is delivered on the water through contractors who are not part of this FTE count.

As part of the 2018/19 budget, the Government approved additional funding of \$2.1 million over four years, and an additional \$731 000 per annum ongoing to help meet the growing cost of the Program. This forms part of the larger departmental Shark Control Program, with total funding of \$16.1 million over four years and \$4.2 million per annum ongoing.

#### Nets and Drumlines:

Over the last five years, the total amount of shark control apparatus has increased.
