Mr J Lister asked Premier and Minister for Trade (Hon. A Palaszczuk)—

QUESTION:

With reference to the meetings with various entities listed on Palaszczuk Government Cabinet Ministers' diary disclosure for 1 September 2018 at the Labor Party conference—

Will the Premier advice (a) what advice the Premier required her cabinet to obtain in respect of integrity and accountability measures to ensure that no probity or conflict of interest issues arose from meeting with each participant and (b) how the Premier satisfied herself that all requirements under the Integrity Act have been met in response of the meetings involving lobbyists?

ANSWER:

Ministers have the same integrity and accountability requirements for all meetings with stakeholders, regardless of where those meetings occur.

All lobbying activity is required to be entered upon lobbyists register overseen by the Integrity Commissioner and is available for public inspection.
