MR R STEVENS ASKED MINISTER FOR HOUSING AND PUBLIC WORKS; MINISTER FOR DIGITAL TECHNOLOGY; MINISTER FOR SPORT (HON M DE BRENNI)

Will the Minister outline, as at 1 November 2018, (a) the total number of government ICT projects reported on the ICT dashboard and (b) for government ICT projects not reported on the ICT dashboard (i) the total number of projects, (ii) the total value of the projects, (iii) how many are behind schedule, (iv) the amount spent on these projects to date and (v) the total amount that these projects have over-run budget expense?

ANSWER

The Digital Projects Dashboard provides information on significant government digital projects. The Dashboard displays information decided by individual agencies and can be accessed at www.qld.gov.au/digitalprojectsdashboard.

The total number of government ICT projects reported on the ICT dashboard as at 1 November 2018 was 154.

The Queensland Government Chief Information Office has published guidance material to assist agencies decide which projects are reported on the dashboard. The decision to report is for individual agencies.
