MR S O'CONNOR asked the Minister for Health and Minister for Ambulance Services (HON DR S MILES) –

QUESTION

With reference to the operation of the Secure Parking facility at the Gold Coast University Hospital by SurePark Pty Ltd—

Will the Minister (a) advise if Gold Coast Health has received any of the agreed revenue from SurePark and (b) if not, if the Minister has any plans to action the contract agreements to ensure the health service receives the funds it is entitled to?

ANSWER

Parking facilities at the Gold Coast University Hospital are delivered via a Build Own Operate scheme. The agreement between Gold Coast Hospital and Health Service (HHS) and SurePark Pty Ltd is commercial-in-confidence.

The commercial agreement with SurePark Pty Ltd provides for Gold Coast HHS to receive a portion of car park revenue if certain conditions are met. At this time, the Gold Coast HHS is not due any revenue from the privately-operated car park, as the conditions have not been met.

I am advised the Gold Coast HHS closely monitors the performance of the Gold Coast University Hospital car park each month.
