**MR L MILLAR** ASKED MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND MAIN ROADS (HON M BAILEY)—

### QUESTION:

With reference to vehicle inspections conducted by the Department of Transport and Main Roads in Central Queensland—

Will the Minister advise for each location (a) the current inspection schedule, (b) the vacancy rate being experienced and (c) the service standard set out?

### ANSWER:

I thank the Member for Gregory for the question.

In Central Queensland, across the local government areas of Rockhampton, Gladstone, Banana, Central Highlands, Isaac, Barcaldine, Longreach, Blackall-Tambo, Winton, and Boulia, inspections are performed at Emerald, Gladstone, Longreach, Rockhampton, Agnes Water, Alpha, Baralaba, Barcaldine, Biloela, Blackall, Boulia, Clermont, Collinsville, Dingo, Middlemount, Miriam Vale, Moranbah, Moura, Muttaborra, Rolleston, Springsure, Tambo, Taroom, Theodore, and Winton. As at the end of the 2016–17 financial year the Department of Transport and Main Roads (the department) conducted 12,817 inspections at those locations. The department regularly reviews booking inspection demand at those sites and adjusts the schedules to meet changing requirements.

All locations in Central Queensland are operating within their respective service standard.

The current inspection schedule, and vacancy rate for each of the locations where the department conducts vehicle inspections in Central Queensland is as follows:

The service delivery standards for vehicle inspections are determined by a number of factors including the level of service required to meet industry demand, and historical data.

These are measured against the number of working days until three inspection slots are available at each location. A standard of three inspections slots is used as it allows for a heavy vehicle combination to be booked in, as each component vehicle of the combination requires one inspection slot.

The service standard for each of the locations in Central Queensland is as follows:
