Mr A HARPER ASKED THE MINISTER FOR FIRE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES (HON C CRAWFORD)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise of future plans for the Kirwan fire station?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for the question.

I am advised by Queensland Fire and Emergency Service (QFES) that future operational needs at Kirwan are being monitored by QFES regional management. QFES regional management in conjunction with the Public Safety Business Agency are actively seeking available land in Kirwan for a replacement Fire and Rescue Station.

I am further advised a replacement Fire and Rescue Station at Kirwan will be considered along with other state wide priorities and subject to budget allocations in future years.
