**MR S MINNIKIN ASKED MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND MAIN ROADS (HON M BAILEY)—**

**QUESTION:**

With reference to the Minister's comment on ABC radio that his ministerial ethical responsibilities were a 'grey area'—

Will the Minister advise how many times since becoming a Minister in 2015 he has (a) sought the advice of the Integrity Commissioner, (b) written to the Department of the Premier and Cabinet, or Cabinet Secretary for advice about his responsibilities and (c) used his MangoCube6 email account for ministerial business?

**ANSWER:**

I thank the Member for Chatsworth for the question, although I do not accept its premise.

Matters relating to the use of my personal email account have been the subject of an investigation by the Crime and Corruption Commission which closed last year.

New ministerial guidelines regarding private email accounts and messaging apps in relation to ministerial business have been released by the Honourable Annastacia Palaszczuk MP, Premier and Minister for Trade, and I am committed to complying with those guidelines.
