DR M ROBINSON asked the Minister for Health and Minister for Ambulance Services (HON DR S MILES)—

QUESTION

With reference to data provided by law to the Chief Health Officer about the number of abortions performed in Queensland clinics (more than 10,000 every year)—

Has the Minister undertaken, and if so will the Minister provide, an estimate of what it would cost for these abortions to all be performed in Queensland public hospitals?

ANSWER

There are no possible scenarios in which all abortions would be performed in Queensland public hospitals and therefore no detailed modelling has been undertaken in this regard.
