QUESTION:

With reference to the Queensland Competition Authority's public workshops carried out as consultation on the setting of regional electricity prices—

Will the Minister advise (in table format) (a) how many workshops were carried out and (b) for each workshop the (i) location, (ii) number of registrations, (iii) number of attendees and (iv) number of one-on-one workshops conducted?

ANSWER:

The Queensland Competition Authority is a statutory authority established under the *Queensland Competition Authority Act 1992* which is administered by the Deputy Premier, Treasurer and Minister for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Partnerships.
