MS A LEAHY ASKED MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND MAIN ROADS (HON M BAILEY)

QUESTION:

With reference to railway fences in disrepair from Miles to Charleville and the proposals to increase the number of cattle trains on this line—

Will the Minister advise when Queensland Rail will repair the hundreds of kilometres of fencing which they have allowed to fall into serious disrepair?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for Warrego for the question.

Queensland Rail works with adjoining property owners to ensure boundaries are appropriately protected, as required.

If there is existing fencing in place that is in disrepair or no longer required by the adjoining property owners, Queensland Rail will provide assistance for its removal or repair.

Should the Member for Warrego have any specific examples, I would encourage the Member to share this information with Queensland Rail to enable them to look into the matter directly.
