**MR A POWELL ASKED MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND MAIN ROADS (HON M BAILEY)**

**QUESTION:**

Will the Minister advise the progress towards meeting recommendation 8 of the Strachan Review, including the outcome of the review?

**ANSWER:**

I thank the Member for Glass House for the question.

Recommendation 8 of the *Queensland Rail Train Crewing Practices Commission of Inquiry* recommends that Queensland Rail conduct a comprehensive review of, and revision to, crewing rules and processes.

As noted in the March 2018 *Fixing the trains* report, published on the Citytrain Response Unit website, Queensland Rail has finalised the consolidation of current crewing rules and processes into a central repository, enabling informed decision making in planning for identified timetable stress periods.

Given that consultation is ongoing with employees regarding the current master roster, Recommendation 8 cannot be closed out until updated crewing rules and processes are finalised, and assured by the Citytrain Response unit.

The City Response Unit has reported Recommendation 8 as being partially complete in March 2018.
