Mr M Berkman asked Premier and Minister for Trade (Hon. A Palaszczuk)—

QUESTION:

With reference to the Palaszczuk Government's key 2017 election commitment to veto any Northern Australia Infrastructure Facility (NAIF) loan to assist in the development of Adani's Carmichael Coal Mine—

Will the Premier commit to veto any other application for assistance from the NAIF for, or associated with, proposed mining development in the Galilee Basin?

ANSWER:

Any NAIF proposal will be given proper consideration and assessed on its merits by the Queensland Government.

The Queensland Government is investing significantly in infrastructure across North Queensland.

I am advised by my Director-General that the Queensland Government is not aware of any other active NAIF proposals relating to mining development in the Galilee Basin.
