MR MICKELBERG ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND MINISTER FOR CORRECTIVE SERVICES (HON M RYAN)—

QUESTION:

With reference to State Reserve Land at 21 and 25 Main Street, Buderim (Lots 2-3 on B4641), which is currently set aside for Police purposes –

Will the Minister advise (a) if the government currently has any plans to divest this land, (b) if any proceeds from the sale of this land will be reinvested in police resources on the Sunshine Coast and (c) will the Minister provide an assurance that the land will not be sold for commercial development and that the land will only be used for a purpose which benefits the community as a whole.

ANSWER:

I am advised by the Public Service Business Agency that this land is currently zoned as 'community facilities' under the Sunshine Coast Planning Scheme 2014.

I am further advised that the Public Safety Business Agency is in preliminary discussions with the Sunshine Coast Council regarding any potential interest in this land.
