Mr R Stevens asked Premier and Minister for Trade (Hon. A Palaszczuk)—

QUESTION:

Will the Premier advise, on a whole-of-government basis (a) the total cost of the Strachan Inquiry, including the cost of departmental resources seconded to the Inquiry and (b) the remuneration and expenses of Mr Strachan to conduct the inquiry?

ANSWER:

- (a) I refer the Member for Mermaid Beach to the answer to Question on Notice No. 1438 of 2017 tabled by the then Deputy Premier, Minister for Transport and Minister for Infrastructure and Planning (The Honourable Jackie Trad) on 9 October 2017.
- (b) The cost of Mr Phillip Strachan's services in relation to the Inquiry was \$200,295. This amount forms part of the total cost of the Inquiry as reported in the answer to Question on Notice No. 1438 of 2017.
