

## **Question on Notice**

**MR C BOYCE** ASKED MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND MAIN ROADS (HON M BAILEY)

### **QUESTION:**

With reference to significant road maintenance problems on the Leichhardt Highway between Wandoan and Taroom in the Callide Electorate, specifically, a road culvert approximately 15km south of Taroom where speed limit restrictions have been in place for well over two years, and the Roche Creek Bridge surface and approaches between Yeovil Road and No. 4 Road—

Will the Minister advise (a) what the Department of Transport and Main Roads is doing about these major highway issues and (b) when we can expect these highway issues to be resolved?

### **ANSWER:**

I thank the Member for Callide for the question.

The Department of Transport and Main Roads advises that:

- (a) reconstruction and resurfacing works to restore the road surface and reinstate road drainage on the section of the Leichhardt Highway approximately 15 kilometres south of Taroom will be completed in October 2018
- (b) resurfacing of the Roche Creek bridge surface and approaches and guardrail repairs will be carried out during the 2018–19 financial year.
