**MR T MANDER** ASKED DEPUTY PREMIER, TREASURER AND MINISTER FOR ABORIGINAL AND TORRES STRAIT ISLANDER PARTNERSHIPS (HON J TRAD)—

### QUESTION:

Will the Treasurer outline how many First Home Owners' Grants (previously known as Great Start Grants) have been paid out to first home-buyers building or buying a new home in each financial year (listed separately and including a column of total cost) since the grant was announced in the 2012-13 State Budget, up until the end of the 2017-18 financial year?

### ANSWER:

The table below displays by financial year the number and value of payments made under the Great Start Grant (GSG) and Queensland First Home Owners' Grant (QFHOG) schemes from 12 September 2012 to 31 May 2018. The GSG and QFHOG are only available for "new dwellings" which include new home, owner builder, off-the-plan and contracts to build.
