MR P WEIR ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND MINISTER FOR CORRECTIVE SERVICES (HON M RYAN)—

QUESTION:

With reference to page 93 of the Capital Statement (Budget Paper No. 3) in relation to \$30m for new and replacement vehicles in 2018-19 —
Will the Minister provide a separate breakdown for the number of 'new' and 'replacement' vehicles under this commitment for the coming year?

ANSWER:

I am advised by the Queensland Police Service (QPS) that the \$30 million provided to the QPS in the 2018-19 Capital Statement for new and replacement vehicles, will deliver 27 new and 796 replacement police vehicles.

Replacement vehicles projected forecast numbers are based on either the age of the vehicle or projected forecast utilisation/kilometres the vehicle will reach within the given financial year.

In total, the QPS budget will support 2,655 vehicles and 65 vessels for policing functions across the State.

There are 106 vehicles carrying over from the 2017-18 build program. The 106 vehicles include 76 replacement vehicles plus 30 new additional vehicles that are currently in build to be provided in the first quarter 2018-19. This will bring the final 2017-18 vehicle fleet capital program delivery to 75 new vehicles and 896 replacement police vehicles.
