**MR L MILLAR** ASKED MINISTER FOR HOUSING AND PUBLIC WORKS; MINISTER FOR DIGITAL TECHNOLOGY; MINISTER FOR SPORT (HON M DE BRENNI)

Will the Minister provide an update on the progress of installing photoelectric smoke alarms in public housing buildings including (a) percentage of buildings with the photoelectric smoke alarms installed, (b) associated costs incurred to date on the photoelectric smoke alarms installed so far and (c) expected overall cost of installing photoelectric smoke alarms in all public housing buildings?

**ANSWER**

- a) 100% of public housing buildings addressed by the smoke alarm program to date have interconnected photoelectric smoke alarms installed.
- b) To date \$2,543,147 has been incurred in costs.
- c) \$73 million has been allocated for the completion of this program.
