MR T NICHOLLS asked the Minister for Health and Minister for Ambulance Services (HON DR S MILES) –

QUESTION

Will the Minister outline the number of midwives employed in Queensland hospitals as at 25 November 2017 and 1 June 2018 (reported separately by Hospital and Health Service)?

ANSWER
