

QUESTION ON NOTICE

MR A PERRETT asked the Minister for Agricultural Industry Development and Fisheries (HON M FURNER)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise in relation to Department of Agriculture and Fisheries (DAF) staff (a) the total number of DAF employees located outside South East Queensland and (b) the location and number of DAF employees each of the regional office locations?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for the question.

As at 22 June 2018, the Department of Agriculture and Fisheries has:

- (a) 675.6 active Full Time Equivalent staff (FTEs) located outside of the South East region of Queensland. This includes 276.6 FTEs in the department's North region, 139.3 FTEs in the Central region and 259.7 FTEs in the South region.
- (b) There are 54 different work centres throughout the North, Central and South regions.

It should be noted that the South East region, excluding the Brisbane CBD, has 702.5 FTEs and the region comprises of an area just north of Bundaberg, west to Monto, Mundubbera, Kingaroy, Gatton, past Beaudesert and to the New South Wales border.
