MR HUNT ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND MINISTER FOR CORRECTIVE SERVICES (HON M RYAN)—

QUESTION:

With reference to the Nambour police station replacement project—
Will the Minister advise (a) what the Nicklin community has received from the \$140,000 spent so far on the delayed Nambour police station and (b) what the \$100,000 budgeted for this year will be spent on?

ANSWER:

The Palaszczuk Government continues to support our police by investing in the resources and infrastructure that they need to keep Queenslanders safe.

Our government made an election commitment to progress the delivery of an improved Nambour Police facility project during this term of the Palaszczuk Government, and we are delivering on that promise.

The Queensland Police Service has advised that funding to date on the Nambour Police facility has been for scoping, planning and design work.

The recent 2018-19 State Budget committed \$100,000 towards scoping works for this project.

The Palaszczuk Government remains committed to this project.
