MR J MCDONALD ASKED MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND MAIN ROADS (HON M BAILEY)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise the historic traffic flow (2010 to most recent) on Brisbane Valley Highway at Fernvale, Warrego Highway at Minden interchange and Forest Hill Fernvale Road between Lowood and Fernvale (broken up into hourly increments and traffic type)?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for Lockyer for the question.

The Department of Transport and Main Roads has recorded annual average daily traffic (AADT) data for the past eight years for these locations. An AADT figure is the number of vehicles passing a point on a road in a 24-hour period, averaged over a calendar year. The AADT data presented in the tables below is for traffic flow in both directions at these locations. It is not possible to provide this information broken into hourly increments.

Traffic flow on the Brisbane Valley Highway at Fernvale from 2010 to 2017 is as follows:
