**MR T MANDER** ASKED DEPUTY PREMIER, TREASURER AND MINISTER FOR ABORIGINAL AND TORRES STRAIT ISLANDER PARTNERSHIPS (HON J TRAD)—

### **QUESTION:**

Will the Deputy Premier advise whether a study has been commissioned into long term global coal thermal and coking demand based on International Energy Agency projections, and if so, what is the expected timeline of this study being completed and made public?

### **ANSWER:**

Queensland Treasury is undertaking a study of long term global thermal and coking coal demand, based on International Energy Agency (IEA) projections, as was committed to by the Government at the 2017 General Election, and evident in my Ministerial Charter letter, published on the Queensland Government website on 6 March 2018.

I am advised the drafting of the report is proceeding and once completed, a copy of the report will be provided for Government's consideration.
