MRS S WILSON ASKED MINISTER FOR AGRICULTURAL INDUSTRY DEVELOPMENT AND FISHERIES (HON M FURNER)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise if the government has any plans for the future use of the former Joondoburri Conference Centre located at 144 North Street, Woorim?

ANSWER:

The Joondoburri Conference Centre is located on land owned and managed by the Department of Agriculture and Fisheries (DAF). The site is the Bribie Island Research Centre and the conference centre is adjacent to the research centre.

The Conference Centre is in a state of decay and has not been used since 2009.

DAF has recently received several expressions of interest in the Joondoburri land area from other government agencies, the University and private sector for aquaculture use and is scoping options for potential development of the site.
