QUESTION:

With reference to the implementation of the government's Waste Disposal Levy—

Will the Minister advise (a) how the small regional communities of the Callide shires of Western Downs Regional Council, Banana Shire Council and North Burnett Regional Council (with less than 600 people, and situated up to three hours from their large waste disposal sites) are going to afford the required infrastructure and (b) whether the Minister will consider an exemption for these larger, isolated shires?
