### QUESTION

Will the Minister outline, in relation to 'code 1' ambulance emergency call outs in Queensland for 2015, 2016, 2017 and 2018 (reported separately by category and year), (a) the overall number of 'code 1' call outs per year, (b) the overall average response time to 'code 1' call outs per year and (c) the overall number of occasions in which another emergency service (fire and/or police - reported separately) arrived at the scene before the ambulance service, per year?
