Will the Minister advise, since the Palaszczuk Government assumed office in 2015, has there been any behaviour or actions that would warrant an application by the Office of Industrial Relations to the Queensland Industrial Relations Commission to revoke a Work Health and Safety Permit of a Construction, Forestry, Maritime, Mining and Energy Union delegate under Section 138 of the Work Health and Safety Act 2011 (Queensland)?
