MR J LISTER ASKED DEPUTY PREMIER, TREASURER AND MINISTER FOR ABORIGINAL AND TORRES STRAIT ISLANDER PARTNERSHIPS (HON J TRAD)—

QUESTION:

Will the Treasurer advise how many businesses have paid payroll tax for each year from 2014-15 to 2017-18 (reported separately in table format, by number of businesses in each region, total annual value and by financial year)?

ANSWER:

Queensland has a very competitive payroll tax regime. Queensland's overall rate of payroll tax, 4.75 per cent, is one of the lowest in the country and the exemption threshold, \$1.1 million, is one of the highest among mainland states.

The value of payroll tax collections has increased by an average of just 1.1 per cent per year between 2014-15 and 2017-18, slower than the rate of total tax revenue growth over the same period.

The 24,140 Queensland businesses paying payroll tax in 2017-18 represented just 5.4 per cent of the 448,725 businesses operating in Queensland at the end of the 2017-18 financial year (total available from Australian Bureau of Statistics, Count of Australian Businesses, cat. no. 8165.0).

The figures in Table 1 below are based on payroll tax annual return data for financial years 2014-15 to 2017-18 as at 21 February 2019. Payroll tax has been categorised into Regional Action Plan (RAP) regions based on the address of the employer.

I note that the previous LNP Government reneged on its commitment to raise the payroll tax threshold, deferring it for two years in the 2013-14 Budget.
