MR M HUNT ASKED MINISTER FOR EDUCATION AND MINISTER FOR INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS (HON G GRACE)

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise when works will commence on the repairs program for the Chevallum State School roofing?

ANSWER:

In 2018–19, \$210 million (excluding GST) is being invested in maintenance at Queensland state schools.

Chevallum State School manages its own maintenance through a direct-to-market approach and is responsible for prioritising the work required at the school from its annual maintenance allocations.

On 11 March 2019, a quote for the audit of all roofs at the school was requested from the Department of Housing and Public Works' Building and Asset Services and is expected to be received shortly. Once the results of the audit are available, this will assist in determining the cost and timing of required works.

The Department of Education's Regional Infrastructure Advisor will support the school through this process and decision making on prioritising the work.
