Mr R Stevens asked Premier and Minister for Trade (Hon. A Palaszczuk)—

QUESTION:

With reference to IT projects—

Will the Premier advise (a) the number of Department of Premier and Cabinet IT projects that are not being reported on the IT dashboard (reported by project), (b) the total value of these projects (reported by project) and (c) the reason that each project is not listed on the IT dashboard?

ANSWER:

The Digital Projects Dashboard is a high-level public communication tool providing information on how projects are tracking against time and estimated cost, as well as access to procurement information, including tender opportunities.

The Queensland Government Chief Information Office provides guidance material to assist agencies and their internal governance committees to decide which projects are reported on the dashboard. Generally, projects are not required to be reported on the dashboard if they are below an approved expenditure threshold or if they are in the initiation stage.

In relation to the Department of the Premier and Cabinet, I am advised that the following projects are not reported on the dashboard as they fall outside of the scope of the dashboard publishing criteria:-
