DR C ROWAN ASKED MINISTER FOR COMMUNITIES AND MINISTER FOR DISABILITY SERVICES (HON C O'ROURKE) —

QUESTION

Will the Minister advise (a) how many departmental medical redundancies or any other form of redundancies have been approved since October 2017 until now and (b) how many positions are vacant as at 31 October 2019?

ANSWER

In accordance with the Annual Report requirements for Queensland Government agencies, information regarding the number of redundancies, early retirement schemes and retrenchment packages paid to employees, and the monetary value of these packages, is required to be reported in annual reports.

As such, I refer the member to the 2017-18 and 2018-19 annual reports of the Department of Communities, Disability Services and Seniors. Information for 2019-20, will be reported in the 2019-20 annual report.

I am advised that as at 31 October 2019, there were 14 vacant positions in the Department of Communities, Disability Services and Seniors.
