Mrs S Wilson asked Premier and Minister for Trade (Hon. A Palaszczuk)—

QUESTION:

With reference to answer to Question on Notice No. 1351 asked on 5 September 2019, involving Labor's former Member for Pumicestone Rick Williams' wife's unpaid National Park permit fees collected through her business, Gateway Bait and Tackle in my electorate—

Will the Premier advise (a) why it took the Palaszczuk Government six months from discovering the unpaid permit fees in January 2018 to terminate the over-the-counter booking agent agreement and (b) what action is the Government taking to recover the hundreds of thousands of dollars of tax payer funds owed to the State by Mrs Williams?
