MR C BOYCE ASKED MINISTER FOR HOUSING AND PUBLIC WORKS; MINISTER FOR DIGITAL TECHNOLOGY; MINISTER FOR SPORT (HON M DE BRENNI)

With reference to the \$40m community infrastructure investment as part of the Active8 Plan—

Will the Minister outline the specific annual funding allocation for 2019-20 to 2011-22 (reported separately by year)?

ANSWER

Active Community Infrastructure is an initiative under the Queensland Government's Activate! Queensland strategy. On 27 July 2019 the Active Community Infrastructure was announced and the \$40 million initiative will deliver around 150 infrastructure projects to benefit Queensland communities over the next three years.

The initiative aims to:

- improve accessibility and provide a greater range of functionality and adaptability of places and spaces
- increase opportunities for individuals and communities to use places and spaces
- provide places and spaces that support broader community social and wellbeing outcomes
- inspire activity in high-need communities across Queensland.

Investment will be considered against a range of principles which may include partnerships, collaboration, integration, inclusiveness and sustainability, as well as the community outcomes to be achieved by the project. Organisations can apply for projects of up to \$1 million (GST exclusive).

The first round opened on 25 October 2019 and \$12.5 million has already been committed against 42 projects to kick-start place-based infrastructure solutions.

The following table outlines the financial allocation per year.
