MR D CRISAFULLI ASKED MINISTER FOR ENVIRONMENT AND THE GREAT BARRIER REEF, MINISTER FOR SCIENCE AND MINISTER FOR THE ARTS (HON L ENOCH)—

QUESTION:

With reference to the vehicle access permits for Minjerribah Recreation Area—

Will the Minister advise (reported separately by year) how much revenue over the forward estimates until 2022-23 is forecast to be raised from (a) permits for a term of one month or less and (b) permits for a term of more than one month?

ANSWER:

I thank the Honourable Member for the question.

Under the Administrative Arrangements Order (No. 1) 2019, the Minister for Employment and Small Business and Minister for Training and Skills Development is responsible for the *Recreation Areas Management Act 2006*, to the extent that it is relevant to the Quandamooka Aboriginal People.

As the Minjerribah Recreation Area is managed by the Quandamooka Yoolooburrabee Aboriginal Corporation, on behalf of the Department of Environment and Science, any questions relating to vehicle access permit fees for the Minjerribah Recreation Area should be asked of the Minister for Employment and Small Business and Minister for Training and Skills Development.

I refer the Member to the relevant Minister.
