MR M BERKMAN ASKED MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND MAIN ROADS (HON M BAILEY)—

QUESTION:

With reference to monitoring cameras and equipment at four sites up to 90kms away from, and leading towards, the Adani Carmichael Coal mine (located at the intersection of the Gregory Development Road and Elgin Road, Belyando; the intersection of Elgin Road and Twin Hills Road, Belyando; intersection of Elgin Road, Bulliwallah Road and Moray Carmichael Boundary Road, Belyando; and Bulliwallah Road, near a small council road base quarry, Belyando)—

Will the Minister advise (a) if these new installations are located on road reserves or state land, (b) who owns the equipment, (c) if the Department has given permission for monitoring systems to be installed at these locations and, if not, is it aware who granted permission, (d) do the monitoring facilities use thermal sensors, infrared sensors, face recognition or vehicle number plate recognition and (e) who has access to the monitoring feeds and information?
